

Less Lethal 1

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Abandoned Warehouse (PB_BB)



Situation: A noise is heard from inside the last room to be cleared. A suspect stands up from behind a cabinet, throws a phone book and grabs a pipe. He is approximately 30 feet or more from your position.

Prologue: As less lethal backup in a group of three officers clearing an abandoned warehouse, you stand down as they ensure there are no lethal threats.

Action: The suspect jumps up and continues to threaten the two officers pointing their weapons at him. After taunting the officers for some time, he jumps over the cabinet and attempts to attack one of the officers. The suspect is fatally shot.

Branching:

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall and shoots the wall behind the desk before the subject stands up the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, at the point he stands until the point he picks up the pipe, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, after the subject picks up the pipe, the subject jumps down behind the cabinet and eventually jumps up and charges at the officers and gets fatally shot.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall at the subject, the desk top in front of him or the wall area around the subject, the subject complies and gives up.

Officer shoots (Beanbag)

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys beanbag, the subject complies and gives up.

Less Lethal 1

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Fatal Branch: If the trainee shoots the subject in a lethal area, the subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Beanbag (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys beanbag, the subject runs and attacks the other officers and is fatally shot.

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot the beanbag at the subject, the subject will comply and give up.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee shoots the subject in a lethal area, the subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Barricaded Suspect (PB_BB)



Situation: A female subject who claims that she has paid her rent for the dumpster area refuses to leave. She is approximately 30 feet or more from your position.

Prologue: You approach another officer who has been talking with the property manager. You go in closer to take the woman into custody.

Action: The subject has a pipe and threatens to hurt you if you come any closer. After threatening you for some time, she runs off.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject runs off.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject runs off.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, she will fall to the ground and comply.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she ducks and runs off.

Officer shoots (Beanbag)

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys beanbag, the subject complies and gives up.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee shoots the subject in a lethal area, the subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Less Lethal 1

Beanbag (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she ducks and runs off.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Barricaded Suspect (OC_T_PB)



Situation: A female subject who claims that she has paid her rent for the dumpster area refuses to leave. She is approximately 10 to 15 feet from your position.

Prologue: You approach another officer who has been talking with the property manager. He briefs you and goes in closer with you to take the woman into custody.

Action: The subject has what appears to be a pipe. She is threatening to hurt the trainee if you come any closer and don't leave her alone. After taunting and threatening the trainee for some time, she attacks the trainee with the pipe.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject attacks.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

OC Branch: The subject staggers back and puts the pipe down.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject ducks and runs off.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the suspect staggers to the ground and gives up.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she screams and runs off.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys the Taser, the subject falls to the ground.

Taser (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she screams and runs off.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Business Dispute (PB_BB_OC_T)



Situation: You are the officer that has been deployed with less lethal because a contractor has become irate and has a stapler in his hand and is threatening people in the office. He has already assaulted one person. The subject appears to be approximately thirty feet from your position, then he moves in closer, approximately 15 feet from you.

Prologue: You approach a woman helping an injured man. She informs you that a man is freaking out. There are two other officers waiting for you.

Action: The subject threatens both officers as well as the trainee. If no action is taken, he comes closer and threatens again. At that point, if the trainee hasn't taken action, the subject attacks the trainee.

At the first distance (Approximately 30 Feet)

Branching:

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

OC Branch (Ineffective): The subject staggers back and then continues to threaten one of the officers.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject attacks one of the officers.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject will go to the ground.

At the second distance (Approximately 15 Feet)

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject attacks the trainee.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

OC Branch (Ineffective): The subject staggers back and then continues to threaten one of the officers.

OC Branch (Effective): The subject falls to the ground and gives up.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject attacks one of the officers.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject goes to the ground.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, he attacks the trainee with the stapler.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys the Taser, the subject falls to the ground.

Taser (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, the subject attacks the trainee with the stapler.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Female With Knife (OC_T_PB)



Situation: A woman, sitting on a piece of cardboard, has a kitchen knife in the ground next to her. She does not respond to commands. She is approximately 15 feet from your position.

Prologue: You are responding as less lethal backup to the report of squatters on private property.

Action: She grabs the knife and taunts the trainee and the officer. After some time she throws the knife at the other officer.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject throws the knife.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

Instructor Override: A woman appears from the bushes and starts yelling at the other officer. The woman sitting on the ground throws the knife at the officer.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls over.

OC Branch: The subject drops the knife and the other officer takes her into custody.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject falls over and the other officer takes the subject into custody.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject screams and attacks the trainee while a woman comes out of the bushes and attacks the other officer.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject falls over and the other officer takes the subject into custody.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she screams and runs off, the other officer chases her and the second subject comes out of the bushes and chases him.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Less Lethal 1

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys Taser, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys Beanbag, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee effectively deploys and shoots, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys the Taser, the subject falls over.

Taser (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she ducts and runs off. The other officer chases her and the second woman comes out of the bushes and chases him.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys Taser, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys Beanbag, the scenario goes to black and ends.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee effectively deploys and shoots, the scenario goes to black and ends.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Female With Knife (PB_BB)



Situation: A woman is sitting on a piece of cardboard. She doesn't want to leave and does not respond to commands. She is approximately 30 feet from your position.

Prologue: You are responding as less lethal backup to the report of squatters on private property.

Action: The subject gets up and goes for a knife that is stuck in the ground. She doesn't attack anyone but she does taunt the other officer. After some time, she runs off.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject runs off.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject falls over and the other officer takes the subject into custody.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject screams and runs off.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject falls over and the other officer takes the subject into custody.

Instructor Override: The subject spins around and begins threatening the trainee, then she runs off.

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys beanbag, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she ducks and runs off.

Officer shoots (Beanbag)

Less Lethal 1

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys beanbag, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee shoots the subject in a lethal area, the subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Beanbag (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, she runs off.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Mentally Disturbed Person (PB_OC_T)



Situation: You are responding a less lethal backup at a construction site. A mentally disturbed woman has entered the construction site and seems to think she is building something with her hammer. She claims she is doing it for Jesus. She refuses to leave so you have to help get her out.

Prologue: The building construction foreman meets you at the front door. He informs you that there is a lady that doesn't belong in the building and isn't one of his employees. She has drawn a line on the carpet and says no one is to cross it.

Action: As the woman pounds on a board with her hammer, she periodically screams and lunges at both the trainee and the other officer on the scene. She then attacks the trainee.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject attacks the trainee.

Woman Pounds A

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Woman Shot (Miss): The subject attacks the trainee with the hammer.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

OC Branch: The subject puts the hammer down and drops to the floor.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee shoots and hits the subject, she falls to the ground.

Loop Scene: The other officer asks if she is clear and waits for a response from the trainee.

Instructor Override: The other officer moves in to cuff the subject.

Taser (Miss): The subject attacks the trainee with the hammer.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject falls over and the other officer takes the subject into custody.

Taser (Effective): If the trainee shoots and hits the subject, she falls to the ground.

Woman Shot (Miss): The subject attacks the trainee with the hammer.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

OC Branch: The subject puts the hammer down and drops to the floor.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee shoots and hits the subject, she falls to the ground.

Loop Scene: The other officer asks if she is clear and waits for a response from the trainee.

Instructor Override: The other officer moves in to cuff the subject.

Taser (Miss): The subject attacks the trainee with the hammer.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Parking Lot Accident (PB_OC_T)



Situation: There are three subjects, a male driver who hit the car of a man and a woman in the parking lot. He seems to have been drinking and is definitely angry. The other two people are calm and collected about the situation.

Prologue: You are responding to a parking lot fender bender. There is an off duty officer on the scene. He briefs you and will wait in case you need him for backup.

Action: The male subject that hit the other car gets angry when the woman puts her cell phone on the hood of his pickup truck. He throws the cell phone on the ground then the other man wants to start a fight. The subject grabs a length of chain from his pickup truck and starts to threaten the two as they flee from the scene. The subject then turns and threatens the trainee.

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject attacks the trainee with the chain.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

OC Branch (Ineffective): The subject staggers back and then continues to threaten the trainee.

OC Branch (Effective): The subject puts the chain down and gives up.
The subject attacks with the chain if not sprayed again.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject runs off.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject staggers to the ground and gives up.

Less Lethal 1

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, the subject drops the chain and runs off.

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys the Taser, the subject falls to the ground.

SINGLE SCREEN SCENARIOS

Terminated Employee (PB_BB_OC_T)



Situation: You have been called in as less lethal backup to a local bank. A man has been terminated and he refuses to leave. The subject is approximately 15 feet from your position at first, then moves farther away until he is approximately 30 feet from you.

Prologue: The bank's branch manager greets you and informs you that they terminated a man today and he will not leave. She leads you to the officer already on the scene.

Action: The man verbally threatens the trainee and other officer. He doesn't seem to respond to verbal commands and says he isn't going to be leaving alone. He then grabs a telephone and begins to threaten you and the officer with the receiver.

At the first distance (Approximately 15 Feet)

Branching:

Default outcome: The subject attacks the trainee.

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Instructor Override: The subject gives up.

OC Branch (Ineffective): The subject takes off his glasses and attacks the trainee.

OC Branch (Effective): The subject backs off and the scenario ends.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject complies and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject runs off towards the other officer.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject will go to the ground.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, the subject yells and runs off.

Less Lethal 1

Officer shoots (Taser)

Taser (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys the Taser, the subject falls to the ground.

Taser (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, the subject yells and runs off.

At the second distance (Approximately 30 Feet)

Branching:

Fatal Branch: The subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Miss Branch: The subject surrenders and the scenario ends.

Officer shoots (PepperBall)

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys PepperBall, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

PepperBall (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys PepperBall, the subject attacks the other officer.

PepperBall (Effective): If the trainee continues to shoot PepperBall, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

PepperBall (Miss): If the trainee shoots and misses the subject, the subject yells and runs off.

Officer shoots (Beanbag)

Beanbag (Effective): If the trainee effectively deploys beanbag, the subject goes to the ground and gives up.

Fatal Branch: If the trainee shoots the subject in a lethal area, the subject falls to the ground and the scenario ends.

Beanbag (Ineffective): If the trainee ineffectively deploys beanbag, the subject runs off.
